Sanction is hereby accorded to the Accord of Administrative Approval for "Extension of Grid Supply to Panchtarni by way of laying of underground cabling system (from Sangam Top to Panchtarni)." at a cost of Rs. 902.37 lacs (Rupees Nine Crore, two lacs & thirty-seven thousand only) under Capex Budget(SANJY) 2024-25:-

- The Accord of Administrative Approval is subject to the following conditions:-
1. The funds shall be utilized after fulfilling all codal formalities as provided in the GFR-2017 and work manual-2019.
 2. The execution of work on this project shall be taken up only after funds for the scheme are made available by the competent authority and as per specifications approved by the Techno-Economic Committee.
 3. The actual construction shall be taken up only after the accord of technical sanction by the competent authority.
 4. There shall be no time or cost overrun involved in the project, and a set timeline is strictly adhered to.
 5. The NOC from the concerned Departments is sought before the commencement of work.
 6. The structural design of each work is authenticated by the Competent Authority.
 7. The project and its allied accessories, like land, etc, are encumbrance-free.
 8. That the Lump sum provisions, either in terms of percentage or fixed as made for certain components, are provisional and shall be subject to detailed estimates of cost based on actual measurements, requirements and relevant rates based on specified specifications and made to be framed and approved by competent authorities before the invitation of tenders in accordance with set codal procedures.

9. The e-tendering mode is followed for fixing the award of the contract for the execution of the project, and a working DPR is followed in the formation of the BOQ for the tendering purpose of the project.
10. The proper rate analysis and market survey have been conducted in light of standing rules and procedures in case of all the items proposed to be executed on the ground prior to issuance of formal NIT for the project, to ensure rationality of rates.
11. That there will be no such condition kept in bidding documents which shall restrict the competition.
12. Administrative approval shall be subject to the release of funds from the competent authority.
13. The physical/financial achievements shall be submitted to the Administrative Department well before the timeline.
14. It must be ensured that there shall be no multi-source funding or overlapping schemes under different programmes.
15. The funds are available from an authentic source like UT Capex Budget or CSS Scheme, etc.
