Subject: Constitution of the Management Committee for the Shrine of Shri Machail Mata Ji.

Government Order No: 102-JK(TSM) of 2022
Dated: 06 .09.2022

Sanction is hereby accorded to the constitution of the Management Committee to look after the administration, funds, management and governance of the Shrine of Shri Machail Mata Ji. The composition of the Management Committee shall be as follows:

1	Divisional Commissioner, if he is a Hindu; and in case he is not a Hindu, the Deputy Commissioner Kishtwar, if he is a Hindu. In case both of them do not profess Hindu faith, an eminent person professing Hindu faith to be nominated by the Government.	Chairperson
2	Deputy Commissioner Kishtwar, and in case he is the Chairman or is not a Hindu, the Additional District Development Commissioner Kishtwar, if he is a Hindu; in case he is not a Hindu, any other officer professing Hindu faith to be nominated by the Government not below the rank of Special Secretary to the Government.	Vice Chairperson
3	Director Tourism Jammu and in case he is not a Hindu, any other officer nominated by the Government not below the rank of Additional Secretary to the Government.	Member
4	Additional Deputy Commissioner Kishtwar and in case he is not a Hindu, any other officer nominated by the Government not below the rank of Additional Secretary to the Government.	Executive Officer/ Member Secretary
5	03 eminent personalities from the field of social service/legal affairs with adequate knowledge of Hindu religion and shall be nominated later by the Government. All the officers/eminent personalities should belong to the Hindu community and if otherwise, the chairman may opt his or her substitute.	Non-official Members

The Management Committee shall be responsible for:

1. Making arrangements for the smooth conduct of Shri Machail Mata Ji Yatra and performance of worship at Shrine by the pilgrims.
2. Providing facilities to the pilgrims/devotees;

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3. Making arrangements for the safe custody of the funds, valuable and jewellery;
4. Undertaking the developmental activities concerning the areas of the Shrine and its surrounding out of the funds of the Shrine, aimed to facilitate the pilgrimage of the devotees;
5. Making provision for medical relief of the worshippers and pilgrims; and
6. Doing all such things as may be identical to and conducive for the efficient management, maintenance and administration of the Shrine and the Shrine fund and for convenience of the pilgrims.


